Infection Control and Safety Guidelines

We adhere to the following infection control guidelines to protect Dream Flyers and our crew.

- Pilots and Crew Chiefs sanitize their hands prior to assisting each new Dream Flyer.
- Flight helmets are sanitized before each flight.
- After each Dream Flight, the crew sanitizes surfaces that may have been touched by Dream Flyers during the flight. These areas include the center section of the cockpit, the handles, and the sides of the cockpit.
- Any pilots and crew members with symptoms that include cough, fever, sore throat, congestion, diarrhea, etc., will not fly or participate in Dream Flight events.
- Should a crew member become ill during the flight or within 14 days after the flight, Dream Flights will notify the Senior Care Community or Dream Flyer and their family immediately.
- Pilots and Crew Chiefs will wear face coverings when loading and unloading Dream Flyers.
- Microphones on the flight headsets will not be used.

Help Keep Everyone Safe!

- Do not bring veterans, residents, or staff to the airport if they are experiencing signs and symptoms that include cough, fever, sore throat, congestion, diarrhea, etc. Please communicate this request to family and friends who may want to attend a Dream Flight event.
- Notify Dream Flights immediately if a resident we interacted with becomes ill within 14 days of the event. **Merilyn Chaffee:** merilync@dreamflights.org.
